Levels of Riding Achievement Certificates

Level 1

Beginner riders can:

- Groom a horse and pick up feet
Move safely around a horse
Trot on their own
Lead a horse
Saddle and unsaddle a horse
Learn the basics of showing a led horse

Level 2

Intermediate riders can:

- Tie a horse securely
Ride safely in a group
Canter on their own
Ride a simple pattern on their own
Attempt working patterns / use a stock whip safely
Learn the basics of showing in a ridden event
Learn the basics to enter a Youth Judging event

Level 3

Advanced Intermediates can:

- Fit gear correctly
Jump 60cms from a trot
Know diagonals at trot
Know the correct lead at the canter
Demonstrate longitudinal flexion
Attempt cattle events / mechanical cow
Attempt Challenge events
