Rules and Conditions

- 1 Competitors must be able to produce a current ASHS membership card when requested and when purchasing entry tickets.
- 2 No competitor under 18yrs may lead or ride a Stallion or Colt on the grounds or in classes during the Branch Show.
- 3 All Competitors must wear a current ASA Approved Safety Helmet and smooth soled riding boots, when mounted. All junior competitors must wear a current ASA approved helmet at all times when handling a horse.
- 4 The committee has the right to delete, defer or alter the program and have the right to refuse any entry.
- 5 No dogs on grounds.
- 6 Any person handling a horse must be an ASHS member or Day Member.
- 7 Electrical extension leads may be used; battery backup or generators to power camp sites are allowed.
- 8 Stallions and Colts are to be bitted or hobbled or double tied when not in a yard.
- 9 In classes stating Maiden Horse and Maiden Rider, both horse and rider never to have won any classes at any other show previously.
- 10 Gate to be closed at night.
- 11 Parents must take full responsibility for their children and ensure appropriate behavior and that the children do not go to areas of the grounds not involved with the facilities directly associated with the show.
- 12 Yards available at cost – please indicate on your entry form your requirements.
- 13 Rubbish bins are provided around the grounds. Please ensure the area is kept tidy and deposit rubbish in the bins. Skips will be provided for rubbish please use these.
- 14 Competitors are required to clean up all manure, hay and feed to designated points around the grounds.

Neither the organizing committee, the Australian Stock Horse Society Ltd. or Glenormiston College accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury nor illness to horses, riders, beasts, ground spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

Protest Procedures:

The Judges' decision is final.

- 14.1 Any competitor or exhibitor may lodge a complaint in writing to the (Show) Secretary of the Show Committee within 30 minutes of the completion of the event.
- 14.2 The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$50 (recommended by the Show Committee) and is refundable if the protest is upheld.
- 14.3 The complaint shall be heard by the Protest Committee and will be dealt with as the committee shall direct. The Protest Committee will consist of the Show Manager and 2 other members of the Show Committee.
- 14.4 The Protest Committee will deal with problems involving the show not covered by the rules of the ASHS Events Handbook.

Other rules and regulations relating to complaints or protests are specifically covered in the ASHS – Events Handbook Section 1 – Page 11 (1st April 2004)
